Crump, is a renowned civil rights attorney who has represented many high-profile civil rights cases including Trayvon Martin, Michael Brown, and others.

A new Netflix documentary, CIVIL, follows Crump and his justice career and the lives he has impacted. He has also been featured in many docudramas. Crump's book, published in October 2019, Open Season: Legalized Genocide of Colored People, reflects on the landmark cases he has battled, and how discrimination in the courthouse devastates real families and communities.

Conference attendees will also hear from dynamic speakers at informative plenary sessions and panel discussions including Dr. Somava Stout, from the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health; Dr. Cid Pinedo, Chief Executive Officer of the Mexican American Opportunity Foundation; Public Health Director Kim Saruwatari and Medical Officer Dr. Geoffrey from Riverside University Health System; Dr. Evita Limon Rocha and more.
